# 14.00-15.30 ICT TOOL

Valeria Ferraris updated the team on the progress of the ICT tool. After explaining some issues that caused a delay in the work, she showed a preview of the tool and illustrated the next steps.

The Italian language is almost ready: our consultant is fixing small things that we noticed after several days of checks. Then, he will start to duplicate in every language, starting with French, and then the other languages will follow. The last one will be the English version, taking into account that none of us needs it.

#### **NATIONAL EVENTS**

Valeria Ferraris recalled that each partner will organize a national event to disseminate whistleblowing and open data reports or to present the ICT tool. She reported that the University of Turin held an event in May 2020 aimed at Public Administrations to discuss Whistleblower directive and Italian legislation and the usefulness of a self-assessment tool.

She proposed to the other partners to think about what kind of event to organize online, and to fill in a file to share on google drive indicating the essential information: when it will be held, who will be the public, who will be the speakers and what will be the topic.





### **WOODIE FINAL EVENT**

The main part of the meeting was dedicated to the organization of the final event of the Woodie project. Taking into account the current pandemic situation, it will certainly take place online. It was decided to hold two separate meetings lasting about two hours each, one dedicated to whistleblowing and the other to open data. All partners agreed not to limit these meetings to the presentation of comparative reports on the two topics. Instead, it was decided that after a short presentation of the reports, significant figures will intervene on the topic to create a debate. All partners agree and undertake to think about who could be invited as a speaker.
